Entries Close 23 July 2026 at 12.00 pm

1. Eligibility to participate

Amateurs (Girls and Boys) born in 2007 or later, who are members of a German golf club associated with the German Golf Association (DGV) or a foreign golf club associated with its respective national golf association.

2. Limit of handicap-index

Entries will only be accepted from players with an Official World Handicap Index of 12.4 or less for Girls and 7.4 or less for Boys held at an affiliated club to their National Union.

Exemption clause:

Players in

position 1 -7 AK 16 Girls Ranking "National German Championship Qualifier"

position 1 -3 AK 14 Girls Ranking "National German Championship Qualifier"

position 1 -7 AK 16 Boys Ranking "National German Championship Qualifier"

position 1 -3 AK 14 Girls Ranking "National German Championship Qualifier"

after Bavarian Youth Championship are exempt.

3. Maximum of entries:

Girls 48

Boys 60

Remaining players who have failed to achieve a place in the starting field will be placed on a reserve list, in Handicap Index order. If the Handicap Index is equal, there will be a decision by lot.

If a player will move up he or she will be informed by Bayerischer Golfverband at the latest by Thursday 30. July 2026 (12.00 pm).

4. Handicap-relevant

The competition is HCPI-relevant.

5. Mode of play

54 holes stroke play (3 rounds)

Separate Gross Competition for Girls & Boys



Monday Practice round free of charge

Tuesday 1st round 18 holes

Wednesday 2nd round 18 holes

Thursday 3rd round 18 holes and Prize Giving Ceremony

Top 21 Girls and ties and top 39 Boys and ties will qualify for the 3rd round on Thursday.

6. Valuation

Separate Gross valuation for Girls and Boys.

Ties

The Winner (Girls and Boys separated) shall be the competitor who returns the lowest score over the 54 holes. In the event of a tie, there will be a hole by hole sudden death play-off, holes to be decided by the Championship Committee.

In case of ties for all other places, this will be decided by the lowest score for the final 36 holes, then for the final 18 holes (or last 9, 6, 3 or 1 hole(s)) as required. If a tie still exists, there will be a decision by draw.

7. Tees

Male and female competitors will play from separate teeing grounds. The final teeing grounds will be decided by the Championship Committee at the host venue - posted on the notice board.

8. Winner & Prizes

Girls 1. - 3. gross

Boys 1. - 3. gross

Special Ranking

Girls age 16 and younger 1. - 3. gross

Boys age 16 and younger 1. - 3. gross

9. Championship Committee

Will be deployed by Bayerischer Golfverband e.V.

10. Closing date/Entrance fee/Entry form

Closing date for the Championship:

23 July 2026 12.00 pm

Entry fee:

€ 110,- to be paid by 31. July 2026 (otherwise not eligible to compete)

Notice: The Entry fee has to be paid if the player withdraws after the closing date.

In case of a successful registration the player receives a confirmation via email.

The list of accepted players and the waiting list will be published online after the closing date.
